The fifth section is an alphabetical listing honoring those contributors who supported the ASHRAE at the *Major Investors* level (\$250 to \$2,499).

The sixth section lists all Honor Roll level investors (\$100 for individuals/\$150 for companies) by their region and chapter.

The seventh section lists *memorial contributions* received in honor of deceased members, friends and business associates.

The last section lists *endowed research contributions* that will continue supporting ASHRAE into perpetuity.

We would also like to recognize the companies that have permitted their employees to solicit research funds during company business hours. To each of these companies we extend a very special *thank you* for this invaluable contribution. In addition, we wish to express our gratitude to the more than 1900 investors who supported ASHRAE this past year below the honor roll level and could not listed on these pages because of space limitations.
