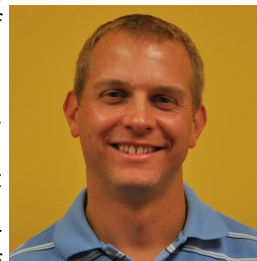

**HISTORIAN'S REPORT**

Last week we received the sad news about the passing of Presidential ASHRAE member, Lynn Bellenger. On March 3, 2010 our chapter had the privilege of having Mrs. Bellenger as our guest speaker for our meeting on the subject of sustainability. The topic she addressed that day was ASHRAE Std. 189.1 - Standard for High Performance Green Buildings, which directly correlated to her ASHRAE Presidential message that year: "Modeling a Sustainable World." That year, Mrs. Bellenger became the first female president of ASHRAE's board of directors. She was a founding partner of Pathfinder, an A&E firm headquartered in Rochester, NY.
